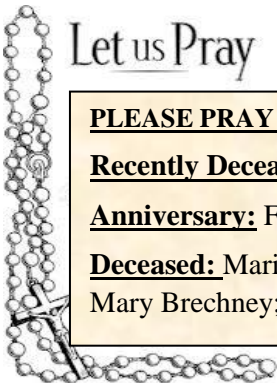
ENTRANCE I am the salvation of the people, says the Lord. Should they cry to me in any distress, I will hear them, and I will be their Lord for ever.

COLUMBARIUM MEMEORIAL GARDEN There is a display in the foyer showing what it will look like. Information brochures are also available. Sales will commence at the end of September. Those who have placed their names on the waiting list will be contacted at that time. Constructed of granite and marble, each wall and garden will be dedicated to a Saint. These will be: Our Lady; St. Joseph; St. Joachim, St. Anne (parents of Mary); St. Therese of Lisieux; St. Mary MacKillop; and St. John Paul II. A white Carrara marble statue of each Saint will be placed in each garden dedicated to them. SACRAMENT OF FIRST HOLY COMMUNION 2024 This Sacrament will be celebrated on **Sunday 24th November 2024**. It is available to all children in Year 3 or above who have been baptised and have received the sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession). If you wish your child to make this Sacrament you **MUST** attend the first lesson for this programme on ***Saturday 19th October, 2024 commencing at 4.15p.m. Please bring a copy of your child's full birth certificate, and if they were not baptised in Rosemeadow Parish, a copy of their baptism certificate.*** Children will participate in lessons in the St. Joachim Parish Hall.
