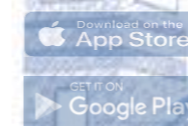

GOSPEL READING Have you ever wondered why we sit for the first two Readings at Mass but stand for the Gospel? The reason is because the first Readings tell us *about* what Jesus and the Apostles said and did, hence they are written in the second and third person. But the Gospels record the *actual* words and actions of Jesus, hence they are written in the first person. Since the Bible is the living word of God, when the Gospel is proclaimed, it is Jesus Himself speaking to us, therefore we always stand to hear the Gospel proclaimed. **Therefore, may I ask that everyone remain standing until I place the lectionary on the stand at the front of the pulpit.** After I have bowed profoundly to the Book, please be seated. Thank you.
