SACRAMENT OF FIRST RECONCILIATION (CONFESSION) 2025 This Sacrament will be celebrated on Thursday 20th March 2025 from 4.15pm. It is available to all children who are in Year 3 or above and have been baptised. If you wish your child to make this Sacrament with the option of receiving their First Holy Communion later in the year, you MUST attend the first lesson for this programme on Saturday 15th February, 2025 commencing at 4.15pm. Please bring a photocopy of your child's full birth certificate, and if they

were not baptised in Rosemeadow Parish, a copy of their baptism certificate. Children will participate in lessons in the St. Joachim Parish Hall. Parents will participate in talks in the Parish Meeting Room. This is the last opportunity for you to enrol for 2025. The programme fee of \$25 is also payable at the first lesson. NOTE: If you are enrolling at the first lesson, please arrive at 3.45pm to the Parish Hall before the lesson to complete the paperwork. Forms can also be downloaded from the Parish website. JUBILEE YEAR OF HOPE 2025

Our Lady Help Of Christians Parish Church, Rosemeadow Designated Special Place of Pilgrimage

Jubilee Indulgence

During the Ordinary Jubilee of 2025, all the faithful, who are truly repentant and free from any affection for sin (including venial sin) and who, during the Holy Year, purified through the sacrament of penance and refreshed by Holy Communion, pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff, will be able to obtain from the treasury of the Church a plenary indulgence, with remission and forgiveness of all their sins, which can be applied in suffrage to the souls in Purgatory in the following ways.

1. Pilgrimages

The faithful, pilgrims of hope, will be able to obtain the Jubilee Indulgence granted by the Holy Father if they undertake a pious pilgrimage:

to any sacred Jubilee site: by devoutly participating in Holy Mass; a ritual Mass for the conferral of the sacraments of Christian Initiation or the Anointing of the Sick; or any of the following: a celebration of the Word of God; the Liturgy of the Hours (office of readings, lauds, vespers); the Via Crucis (Stations of the Cross); the Marian Rosary; the recitation of the Akathist hymn; a penitential celebration, which ends with the individual confessions of the penitents. (This includes OLHC Parish Church).

in Rome: by visiting at least one of the four Major Papal Basilicas: St. Peter's in the Vatican, the Archbasilica of the Holy Saviour (St John Lateran's), Saint Mary Major's, and St. Paul's Outside the Walls.

in the Holy Land: by visiting at least one of the three basilicas: the Basilica of the Holy Sepulchre in Jerusalem, the Basilica of the Nativity in Bethlehem, or the Basilica of the Annunciation in Nazareth.

in other ecclesiastical areas: by visiting the Cathedral or other church or sacred place designated by the local Ordinary. (This includes OLHC Parish Church). (Next week, how to gain the Jubilee Indulgence-Pious visits to sacred places)
