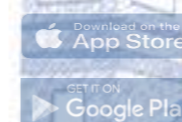

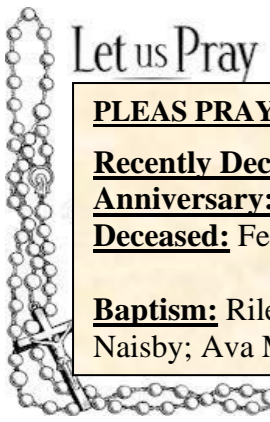
ENTRANCE All the earth shall bow down before you, O God, and shall sing to you, shall sing to your name, o Most High!

MASS ATTENDANCE UPDATE. The following requirements apply:

- Attendees limited to 1 person per 2 square meters, meaning up to 400 people at Rosemeadow
- **QR check-in is still required in Places of Worship**
- Face masks **MUST BE WORN INDOORS**
- **CHURCH OPEN:** The church will now be open during the day (*except Monday*) for private prayer. Please ensure you use the QR registration as you enter.
- Social distancing recommended wherever possible
- Hand sanitiser to be used
- Congregational singing is permitted. *Please note: it will take some time for choirs to be organised and for singing to re-commence*
- After Mass, please use a disinfectant wipe to rub over surfaces you have come in contact with and place them in the bins provided as you leave. *Please wait until the priest has left the Sanctuary before doing this. Thank you.*

MASS ATTENDANCE REGISTRATION From 1 January 2022 **ALL ENTRY TO THE CHURCH WILL BE BY QR CHECK-IN ONLY.** Pre-registration by Eventbrite will no longer be possible. Once you have checked in, simply show the check-in screen with the green tick on your device to the monitor. **Vaccination certificate does NOT need to be shown.** Please arrive **AT LEAST 15 MINUTES BEFORE** the start of Mass to avoid delay. *Once Mass starts, the doors will be closed.*

SACRAMENTS 2022 Enrolment forms and dates for all sacraments –Reconciliation (First Confession), First Holy Communion and Confirmation– have been uploaded to the Parish website. Please download, print and complete the form, and bring it to the first lesson of each sacrament. Please bring a full photocopy of your child's birth certificate, and if they were not baptised in Rosemeadow Parish, their baptism certificate. If you do not have access to a computer, the forms will be available at the first lesson for you to complete.
