HOLY COMMUNION Please remember that when receiving Holy Communion, you must consume the Sacred Host immediately while facing the Altar, and NOT while walking way or returning to your seat. Thank you.

<u>FIRST FRIDAY</u> There will be Exposition and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament this coming First Friday 7th March from 11am to 12 noon.

PLEASE NOTE Due to Ash Wednesday, there will **NOT** be Exposition before morning Mass this week.

<u>ASH WEDNESDAY</u> This week we begin Lent with Ash Wednesday 5th March. Masses in the parish at which blessed ashes will be distributed will be at **9am**, **10.30am** (primary school present) and **7.00pm**.

LENTEN PENANCE On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday all who have completed their 18th year and have not yet begun their 60th year are bound to **fast**. All who have completed their 14th year are bound to abstain from meat. Pastors, teachers, parents are to ensure that even those who, by reason of their age, are not bound by the law of fasting and abstinence from meat, are taught the true meaning of penance. On all other Fridays of the year, including Lent, the law of the common practice of penance is fulfilled by performing any spiritual act such as prayer, self-denial, or charity.

<u>PASCHAL PRECEPT</u> Each of the faithful is obliged to receive Holy Communion at least once a year. This is to be done between Ash Wednesday (5 March) and Trinity Sunday (15 June) unless for a good reason it is done at another time during the year. All the faithful are obliged to confess their grave sins at least once a year.

OLD PALMS Please return old palms so they can be burnt for use on Ash Wednesday. Place in box in foyer.

<u>LENTEN REFLECTION BOOK</u> Once again our Diocese has produced this wonderful reflection booklet this year 'Metanoia'. They are available at the church door. It is an honesty system so please place the money in the box provided. They are \$6 each and contain reflections for 8 weeks from the Ash Wednesday through to Easter Sunday. I highly recommend them as a wonderful way to guide our prayerful daily reflections as we prepare for the Paschal Mystery of Our Lord's Death and Resurrection.

<u>LENTEN REFLECTION GROUP</u> Mrs Kristina Knight will be running a group to reflect on the Lenten Gospels based on the Diocesan *Metanoia* program with daily reflections. It will meet every Tuesday during Lent commencing Tuesday **4**th **March at 1pm** in the parish meeting room. *Metanoia* reflection books available from the Church Foyer or Piety Store.
