LENTEN PENANCE On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday all who have completed their 18th year and have not yet begun their 60th year are bound to *fast and abstinence*. All who have completed their 14th year are bound to *abstain from meat*. Pastors, teachers, parents are to ensure that even those who, by reason of their age, are not bound by the law of fasting and abstinence from meat, are taught the true meaning of penance.

PASCHAL PRECEPT Each of the faithful is obliged to receive Holy Communion at least once a year. This is to be done between Ash Wednesday (11 February) and Trinity Sunday (26 May) unless for a good reason it is done at another time during the year. All the faithful are obliged to confess their grave sins at least once a year.
