DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY Will be celebrated NEXT SUNDAY 27th April. It reminds us of the Divine Mercy from the Heart of Jesus that was poured forth on mankind, and on the whole world, from the Cross by which we were forgiven, redeemed and saved. The Devotion will consist of Exposition, Scripture and Sermon; the Chaplet of Divine Mercy and conclude with Benediction. SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION 2025 This Sacrament will be celebrated on Saturday 31st May 2025. It is available to all children who are in Year 6 or above and have made their First Communion. If you wish your child to receive this Sacrament you MUST attend the first lesson for this programme on Saturday 3rd May 2025 commencing at 4.15p.m. Please bring a photocopy of your child's full birth certificate, and if they were not baptised in Rosemeadow Parish, a copy of their baptism certificate. Children will participate in lessons in the St. Joachim Parish Hall. This is the last opportunity for you to

enrol for 2025. The programme fee of \$25 is also payable at the first lesson. NOTE: If you will be enrolling at the first lesson, then please arrive at 3.45pm to the Parish Hall before the lesson to complete the paperwork. Forms can also be downloaded from the Parish website. Thank you.
