

NOVEMBER MASSES November is the month of the Holy Souls. While we pray for the Faithful Departed always, in a special way we remember the Holy Souls during November. Therefore, no individual names will be printed in the bulletin during November. November Mass Offering Envelopes with names of the dead will be placed on the Altar, and all Masses during November will be offered for them. Mass offering envelopes are included in the Planned Giving Sets, and at the Front Notice Board.

ALL SAINTS DAY occurs this Tuesday 1st November. **Mass as usual at 6.30pm.**

ALL SOULS DAY occurs this Wednesday 2nd November. **Mass will be celebrated at 9.00am and 6.30pm.**

PLEASE NOTE: There not be Exposition before Mass this Wednesday.

PLENARY INDULGENCE may be gained for the Holy Souls in Purgatory by visiting a church on that day and praying the Lord's Prayer and the Creed. Three conditions are required for gaining the indulgence: sacramental Confession, Eucharistic Communion, and prayer for the Pope's intentions.

FIRST FRIDAY DEVOTIONS There will be Exposition and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament this coming first Friday, 4th November, from 11am to 12noon.

NEW PARISH ROSARY GROUP A couple of parishioners have asked if they could start up a Rosary Group for men in the parish. COVID UPDATE From the weekend of 29/30 October the remaining restrictions within the Diocese of Wollongong will be lifted. This means that:

- The obligation to attend Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation will be reinstated.
- Holy Communion may once again be received on the tongue. **Anyone wishing to do so, should come to the Priest only**, and not the lay extraordinary minister of Holy Communion.
- Holy water may again be used in holy water fonts and stoups.
