The area will be divided into gardens and walls constructed of granite and marble, with each dedicated to a Saint. A white Carrara marble statue of each Saint will be placed in each garden dedicated to them and landscaped with variegated pebbles. It will be a very beautiful and appropriate consecrated resting place for loved ones next to the church as they await their resurrection with Christ at the end of time when He returns in glory.
