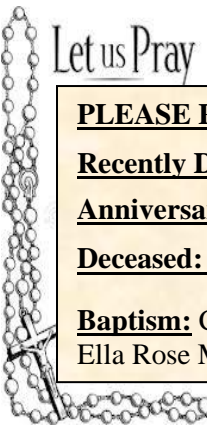
ENTRANCE Cry out with joy to God, all the earth; O Sing to the glory of his name.
