STATUES & ICONS It has come to my attention that many people have been touching the statues and icons in the church again. While I understand and respect the devotional aspect of wishing to do this, I ask that you please refrain from doing so. All the statues and icons have been specially commissioned, and many have been enhanced with gilding (gold). Touching them has a detrimental effect and therefore I ask that they NOT BE TOUCHED as this will damage the gilding and paintwork. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

<u>PASCHAL PRECEPT</u> Each of the faithful is obliged to receive Holy Communion at least once a year. This is to be done between Ash Wednesday (5 March) and Trinity Sunday (15 June) unless for a good reason it is done at another time during the year. All the faithful are obliged to confess their grave sins at least once a year.

<u>PLANNED GIVING ENVELOPES</u> New sets of envelopes are now available for the new financial year to be collected from the church foyer. <u>PLEASE NOTE</u> the Parish requires you to **DESTROY** old envelopes and **ONLY** use new envelopes that have been allocated to you commencing week ending 6 July 2025.
